VINEYARD

Composed of declassified Bentrack Chardonnay alongside fruit from the Domaine de la Côte estate and Rinconada Vineyard, this bottling offers a true snapshot of the appellation in the 2015 vintage.

TASTING NOTE

The wine bespeaks the warm growing season with bright, eye-opening aromas of lemon pith, almond skin, crushed white rock, and oyster shells. From such a lifted nose, the palate is surprisingly unctuous. There is an alluring heft to the wine that carries with it flavors of Meyer lemon custard and roasted pine nuts.
