2010 SANDHI PINOT NOIR, SANFORD & BENEDICT: 93 points

Moorman indicated that this was vinified with 100% whole clusters and saw about 10% new wood. This is notably more complex and more elegant as well compared to the Sta. Rita Hills *cuvée* with its high-toned, airy and layered nose that features floral, black raspberry and spiced plum aromas. There is real punch to the rich and beautifully detailed medium bodied flavors that are not only strikingly persistent but impeccably well-balanced too. This is terrific. 93/2016+

2010 SANDHI PINOT NOIR, STA. RITA HILLS: 91 points

Moorman indicated that this was vinified with 50% whole clusters and also saw about 10% new wood. An intensely floral and exceptionally fresh nose of pure and ripe plum, black raspberry liqueur and spice notes. There is really lovely detail to the energetic, rich and extract rich middle weight flavors that possess exquisite balance on the balanced and lingering finish. This dances across the palate the tannins are quite fine. This is well worth considering. 91/2015+

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
